FirstNet Authority has a 10-year initiative to make ongoing investment into the network of approximately \$2 *billion* to expand FirstNet and improve coverage for public safety users.

The FirstNet Authority team will facilitate a discussion regarding specific coverage needs and solicit feedback from attendees. The FirstNet Authority seeks to learn directly from public safety leaders about their respective priorities for investing in enhanced coverage in the future.
