

#### Who is UCA?

- "[E]stablish and maintain a statewide public safety communications network;" and
- "[P]rovide administrative and financial support for statewide 911 emergency services."



### Who is UCA?

• UCA has 5 Divisions:

- Radio responsible for maintaining and expanding public safety radio network (including assisting in upgrades to prepare for P25 system).
- 911 responsible for all 911 responsibilities including NG911 migration.
- Interoperability responsible for assisting agencies in overcoming interoperability challenges.
- P25 responsible for all aspects of upgrading the public safety radio system to the Project 25 standard.
- Administrative responsible for the administrative support of all of the above divisions.


#### **Agencies Served**

- Approximately 365,000 Push-to-Talks/Day on Network.
- Approximately 431.5 Hours of Air-Time per Day.
- Approximately 53,975 Subscribers on the System.
- Maintain 230 Sites/Locations.
- Provide Communications Services for Over 350 Federal, State, and Local Agencies.


# What Makes UCA Unique

- True Statewide Emergency Communications Network.
- Interrelationship Between UCA and the PSAPs, Police Departments, Fire Departments, and Other Emergency Personnel Leads to a Symbiotic Relationship Allowing for a Trusted Independent State Entity with Local Support and Input.
- Combination of Radio Division and 911 Division Under One Organizational Head Allows for Greater Cooperation and Efficiency as Technologies are Leveraged in Partnership and Not Competition.


#### Existing 800 MHz Coverage

# P25 Upgrade

- Harold will be retiring early next year and James Baker is poised to take over as the P25 Division Director.
- We are now approximately 29 months into our statewide radio replacement.
- Almost all of the system has been engineered (1 site remaining).
- 87% of all of UCA's sites have been remediated.
- P25 Equipment has being manufactured for approximately 2/3 of UCA's sites and has been installed in almost 1/2 of UCA's sites.
- Installation continues next summer.

- On schedule for migration beginning in 2023.
- Everything is on target, on schedule, and going well!

#### Interoperability Division

- Statutorily responsible for the promotion of interoperability between agencies;
- Resource for training and emergency response planning;
- Asset for creation of best practices/SOPs for adoption by local agencies;
- Currently planning its second annual interoperability exercise and hopes you will all participate.

- > UCA has executed a contract with Vesta Solutions, a subsidiary of Motorola Solutions to provide a statewide, NG911 ESInet, core services, and call handling equipment.
- Migration is underway and should be fully completed in early 2022.
- Improved 911 service for citizens and first responders.



### What's the story on radios?

- Many legacy radios (XTS, XTL, APX or EF Johnson/Kenwood) radios have the potential of working on the P25 system, depending on flash codes. UCA may be able to offer an unofficial diagnosis of whether your flash code is sufficient;
- If you need a new radio:

- L3Harris is offering 60% off catalog pricing through the end of 2022;
- Motorola has discounts available through the end of 2021;
- EF Johnson/Kenwood has NASPO pricing available;
- UCA will soon be publishing a list of radios that can be programmed on the UCA system as required by Utah R. Admin. P. R174-1-602.

# Applications on UCA's Website

#### These applications include:

- Application for participation on the NG911 system by Dispatch Centers;
- Application for Disbursements from the CAD Restricted Account;
- Application for participation on the radio system or recertification on the radio system;
- Application for a participating addendum to purchase radio consoles or call-handling equipment.
- We will soon be adding an application for a letter of consent to install a BDA (it is an FCC requirement for installation of most BDAs to receive UCA's consent prior to installation).

# Applications on UCA's Website

- Regarding the application for participation on the radio system or recertification on the radio system, Utah R. Admin P. R174-1-504 has dates for recertification which are being extended as follows:
  - State Agencies must recertify by 6/30/23;
  - Counties of the first or second class must apply/recertify by 12/31/22; and
  - All other entities must apply/recertify by 6/30/22.
- Formal notice of these amended dates is being provided.
